BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING  
MAY 14, 2018

CALL TO ORDER: The Board of Education of Unified School District No. 422, State of Kansas, Kiowa County, met for a regular meeting at the school district office, 710 S. Main Street in Greensburg. The meeting was called to order by President Ki Gamble at 12:10 p.m.

APPROVE AGENDA: A motion was made by J. Wynn Fleener and seconded by Paul Kendall to approve the agenda with two additions:  
1. Hire summer school staff  
2. Consider high school musical production

DISCUSS MUSICAL PROGRAM: Kim Stewart presented a proposal to hold a high school musical production every two years. By consensus, the board agreed to support her request.

HIRE SUMMER SCHOOL TEACHERS: A motion was made by J. Wynn Fleener and seconded by Tony Rhodes to hire Lisa Kendall-Brown, Amy Clements and Venus Covey as summer school teachers for 2018, and to hire Missy Cannon as summer school para-educator, with salaries to be the same as in 2017.
