BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING  
NOVEMBER 28, 2023

CALL TO ORDER: The Board of Education of Unified School District No. 422, State of Kansas, Kiowa County, met for a regular meeting at the school district office, 710 S. Main Street in Greensburg. The meeting was called to order by President Ki Gamble at 8:16 p.m.

- DISCUSS BUDGET: The superintendent reviewed budget projections for the 2024-25 fiscal year and the possibility of necessary budget cuts.
- GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS WILL CHANGE: Principal Travis Powell and counselor Melanie Deterding reported on upcoming changes to the state's requirements for high school graduation. Their recommendations will be presented for approval at a future board meeting.
- ACCEPT KITCHEN DISPOSAL BID: A motion was made by Cory Zenger and seconded by Mike Greenleaf to accept the low bid of \$11,131 (less sales tax) from Comfort Pro Inc. for installation of a kitchen plumbing and disposal system.

- DISCUSS CELL PHONE PROPOSAL: The superintendent presented a proposal for implementing a cell phone-free district for students. The proposal will be considered at a future board meeting.
